Ian Millard has a wide commercial and equity litigation practice which also includes commercial drafting.

Ian was made a Queen's Counsel in May 1998 having been at the independent bar since March 1990.

Before that Ian began practice in 1966 (part-time) in a medium sized general firm, had two years experience in a City of London firm specializing in insurance claims before returning to New Zealand and partnership in 1973. Through a series of mergers he became a senior partner in Kensington Swan.

His court cases have covered a wide range of subject matters including several cases to the Supreme Court of New Zealand and to the Privy Council. His clients have included Transpower NZ Limited, the former Electricity Corporation of NZ Limited, Natural Gas Corporation of NZ Ltd, the Crown, the Commerce Commission, the Securities Commission, The New Zealand Anglican Church Pension Fund, Public Trust, various charities, superannuation funds and their members, as well as a wide range of private individual and commercial enterprises. Ian has also acted as an arbitrator on various disputes and as a commercial negotiator including for various Maori groups.
